

How To Shop For A Loan Without Hurting Your Credit Score

Did you hear about the guy who was denied a low-interest rate mortgage because he had looked at rates on many Internet sites and each site checked his credit? Lenders thought that so many credit checks indicated that he had financial problems.

Authorities at Fair Isaac say that such multiple inquiries shouldn't be a problem today because multiple credit checks are handled differently now.

Previously, the credit-scoring model recognized that consumers shop for the best interest rates before buying a house or car. Their searching results in many lenders requesting their credit reports. To compensate for this, multiple auto or mortgage inquiries in any 14-day period were counted as one inquiry.

Now, their new formula to calculate FICO scores has been expanded from 14 days to a 45-day period. That means consumers can shop around for an auto or home

Be Debt Free In 2 Years

If your balance is \$2,000, the interest rate is 18 percent, and you pay the minimum, it will take 18 years to pay it off. Pay double the minimum instead.

If you double your initial payment and pay that same amount every month thereafter, the debt will be retired in just two years. And Deborah McNaughtan, author of *The Get Out of Debt Kit* (Dearborn Trade), says you will save more than \$2,000 in interest.

loan for up to 45 days without affecting their scores. (Some lenders might not yet use the new version.)

The latest FICO version went online in late 2004 at all three credit agencies, TransUnion, Equifax, and Experien.

Other factors in the new version:

- The FICO score ignores all mortgage and auto inquiries made in the 30 days before scoring.
- The score doesn't count requests for your credit report or credit score that are made in order to offer you a "preapproved" credit card offer.

Factors that could negatively affect your score

- Taking several months to shop for a new mortgage or car loan.
- Shopping around in the same year for several lines of credit not associated with a mortgage or car loan.
- Shopping for lines of credit when a score shows they barely qualify for credit they already have.


Garage Sales Tips For Your Kids

Visiting garage sales with your kids can help you find big bargains and helps them learn how to handle money. Here are some tips for successful hunting from Sonia Weis, coauthor of *Pocket Idiot's Guide to Garage and Yard Sales* (Penguin).

Before you go, tell the kids how to act. No running. Behave as guests in a person's home. Be polite. If someone has their hands on an object, don't look at it or say anything until the person puts it down.

Make a list of things they should be on the lookout for, either things that you want or things they want themselves. Each child should have a set amount of money saved from an allowance or that you give them for the hunt. They will learn how to budget their funds and also get the knack of bargaining for a lower price. Tell them how. Pass along these suggestions from Weis in order to help them become good shoppers.

- Test anything electrical to see if it actually does work. Take a few of your own batteries along so they can test toys and other battery-operated items.
- Check to see if all parts of a set or toy are included. Ask for the instructions.
- If you see something you like, pick it up and carry it around with you until you decide if you want it or not.
- When you go during the last hour of the sale, you have an opportunity to ask for a lower price, and sellers will be more willing to give it.
- If you go during the first hour of a sale, the best items will still be there.

What Are Your Kids Saying

If you want to impress your kids, use these skateboarder terms.

- Deck: The actual board not including wheels or axles.
- Grind: To scrape both axles on a rail, bench, curb, or other surface.

- Ollie: Jump performed by tapping the tail of the board on the ground, sending rider and board airborne.

Sinfully Smooth Chocolate Ice Cream

Here's a great recipe to beat the heat and it has been an Indiana State Fair winner at the "Ice Cream Crank-Off."

2 1/2 Cups Sugar
2 Cups Egg Beaters
2 Pints Heavy Whipping Cream
1 Tbsp. Corn starch
2 Tsp. Pure Vanilla
3 Oz. Unsweetened Chocolate, Melted
3 Cups Half-n-Half

In a large saucepan, mix together sugar and cornstarch. Whisk in the melted chocolate until well blended. Slowly, whisk in the Egg Beaters. To the well-blended mixture, gradually whisk in the Heavy Whipping Cream. Cook over medium heat until heated through and slightly thickened. Remove from heat. Pour into ice cream canister. Add to canister the Half n Half and vanilla. Freeze according to manufacturers directions until set. Allow ice cream to ripen in the freezer packed with ice and wrapped with a towel.

Air Bag At Your Knees

First there were driver air bags and passenger air bags, then came side air bags and side-curtain air bags, and now comes the knee air bag.

The extra safety feature is designed to make sure the driver's body doesn't slide down and forward as a result of the momentum in a front-end collision.

The Chrysler Pacifica, Chrysler Town & Country, and Dodge Caravan feature knee-air-bag systems because the dashboards in these vehicles are farther away from the driver seats.

The Lexus RX 300 sport-utility vehicle and the RX 400 hybrid offer this feature along with the GS 300. The GS 430 luxury sedan has knee air bags for both the driver and the front-seat passenger. And the Toyota Avalon has knee bags.

The degree of how much knee air bags help depends on such factors as the amount of energy involved in the collision, the size of the vehicles involved, the size of the occupants, and how far away the seat is from the dashboard.

Find The Pet You Want

To find a wonderful pet, just visit Petfinder.com. Enter your zip code or city, and up pops a listing of pets along with a photo and description of each animal. There are plenty of dogs, cats, rabbits, birds, and more exotic pets to choose from.

The site was started 10 years ago by Betsy and Jarel Saul of Pittstown, N.J., after making a New Year's resolution to help homeless pets. Today, it lists more than 160,000 animals in shelters across the U.S. Five million pet lovers visit the site every month. According to Nielsen/NetRatings, people stay an average of 20 minutes, longer than on Amazon.

Aside from more common pets, rescue groups post ads offering goats, pigs, cows, sheep, iguanas, bearded dragons, snakes, horses, chinchillas, and chickens.




This month's "Client of the Month" is the Mason family of North Olmsted.
